






TN. HJ. MUSTAPHA HAMAT



SEMINAR & TALK SERIES

We understand how important it is for students to get exposure beyond textbooks. That's why our Seminar & Talk Series focused on bringing real-world insights straight to campus. One of the standout events was the Islamic Finance Dialogue, featuring Mr. Abdullah Haron, a Senior Financial Sector Expert from the IMF. His talk explored how Islamic finance can integrate into global financial systems. With around 30 attendees, the dialogue sparked lively discussions and offered fresh perspectives on the complexities of Islamic finance at a global level.

Another notable session was the Sharing Session with Industry Practitioners on 23rd November 2023. This was a down-to-earth discussion where professionals from SMEs, Islamic banking, and regulatory bodies gave students practical advice on the skills they'll need to succeed in the industry. With a mix of physical and online attendees, this session helped students bridge the gap between their studies and future careers.









RESEARCH & PUBLICATIONS: BUILDING RESEARCH MUSCLE

Research is a cornerstone of academic growth, and this year, we took it to the next level with our II*i*BF Research Recourse (IRR) Series. Across four sessions, we equipped students with essential research tools and skills. The first session on 23rd February 2023 introduced tools like Grammarly and Scite to streamline research work.

We didn't stop there. On 16th March, we brought in Sr. Nur Liyana Abdul Halil from the IIUM Library to give a deep dive into Mendeley, a powerful citation tool. This hands-on session was a game-changer for students juggling with research papers. By the 4th session on 25th November, we even ventured into how AI tools, like ChatGPT, can enhance academic research. In total, around 70-80 students attended these sessions, leaving with a sharpened skill set ready to tackle their academic challenges.









COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT: LEADING WITH COMPASSION

One of the pillars of Islamic banking and finance is social responsibility, and the IIiBFSS has taken this to heart. Our We Care, We Share programme, held on 17-18th March 2023, brought students, staff, and lecturers together to spend time with orphans from Badan Amal Darul Mustafa (BADAM) in Janda Baik. The two-day event was packed with meaningful activities, from congregational prayers to sports, all aimed at uplifting and inspiring these young minds. The best part? We provided them with new school outfits, a gesture that made a lasting impact.

As we move forward, we're excited to continue building on these successes. There's always more to learn, more to give, and more to connect with—and we're here for all of it.






















MODULAR DELIVERY

Master of Science (Islamic Banking and Finance) is a coursework programme whereby students are required to take courses related to Islamic banking and finance to complete their studies.

This modular offering which involves collaborative programme management between IIUM Academy and the IIUM Institute of Islamic Banking and Finance (IIiBF) provides flexible teaching and learning arrangement whereby courses will be taught during weekends in the modular mode. Such an arrangement will give greater opportunity for executives and working adults to manage their time for both work and study at the same time.

The programme is inter-disciplinary in nature whereby students are exposed to various aspects of Islamic banking and finance such as Shariah principles, Islamic banking products and operations, accounting, risk management, takaful, Islamic capital market and wealth management.

Prior to graduation, students are required to produce a research paper in area of their interest within the boundary of Islamic banking and finance.
